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**SECOND STIPULATED ORDER AMENDING ORDER FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF CLASS  
ACTION SETTLEMENT, NOTICE AND SCHEDULING**

WHEREAS, Plaintiff and Defendant have worked diligently to obtain service addresses and billing and payment data for the Class (the "Data") in order to send notices regarding the proposed settlement and calculate each Class member's pro rata share of the Net Settlement Fund;

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen difficulties, Defendant was unavoidably delayed in furnishing the Data to Plaintiff;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Court's Stipulated Order Regarding Preliminary Approval Order of Class Action Settlement, Notice and Scheduling dated September 29, 2020, as

amended by the Stipulated Order Amending Order for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, Notice and Scheduling dated October 21, 2020 (the "Preliminary Approval Order"), is amended as follows:

4. A hearing (the "Settlement Hearing") will be held before this Court on February 18, 2021 at 2:30 pm to determine whether the proposed settlement between Plaintiff and Defendant, on the terms and conditions provided in the Agreement, is fair, reasonable and adequate and should be approved by the Court, to determine whether a final judgment should be entered dismissing this Lawsuit with prejudice, and without costs, and to determine whether to award attorneys' fees and expenses to Class Counsel and the amount of such fees and expenses.


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6. On or before December 2, 2020, Plaintiffs' Counsel shall cause a Notice of Proposed Class Action Settlement ("Notice"), substantially in the form attached to the Agreement as Exhibit "C," to be mailed to members of the Class.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the date of this Order shall be the date of the Court's Preliminary Approval Order for the purposes of Paragraph 23(a) of the Settlement Agreement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions of the Preliminary Approval Order remain in full force and effect.
